


# \$100 REWARD FOR **RED** STRIPED BASS TAG



## **NC STATE UNIVERSITY RESEARCH PLEASE CUT TAG FOR REWARD**

If you catch a striped bass with a **red tag**, please cut off the tag at the base, retain it, and call **(919) 515-4592** to receive the **\$100 reward**.

When you call, we will ask the date, time, and location of capture, the fish's total length (snout to end of tail), and whether the fish was kept or released. If you keep the striped bass and find this tag  in the body cavity, please tell us when you call.

We are studying Striped Bass movement, mortality and distribution in relation to water quality in the Neuse River. Your participation helps our study and efforts to improve the fishery. Thank you for your assistance.
