FISHING REGULATIONS

Fishing regulations for Mountain Heritage Trout Waters, such as daily creel limits, minimum size limits and lure restrictions, are established by the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission.

The 3.25-mile section of Scott Creek from Hospital Rd. (S.R. 1437) to Hometown Place Rd. (S.R. 1381) is classifed as the Sylva Mountain Heritage Trout Water and is a **Hatchery-Supported Trout Water** with the following regulations:

Open season: 7:00 a.m. on the first Saturday in April until the last day of February.

- No bait or lure restriction
- No size limit restriction
- Seven (7) trout per day creel limit
