To possess endangered, threatened, or special concern species in North Carolina, individuals must submit a research proposal with this application, in a hard copy of their objectives for conducting education, rehabilitation, or propagation activities. Applicants must provide documentation of the following:

- ☐ Lawful acquisition, and source, of all animals to be held under this permit
- ☐ Experience and/or qualifications of the applicant to ensure proper handling and care of captive animals
- ☐ Compliance with the minimum caging requirements for each species to be held under this permit, as specified in the captivity rules 15A NCAC 10H.1404
- ☐ Objectives for conducting education, rehabilitation, or propagation activities
